Recurve Bow: Round FITA 1440. Shoot 36 arrows in 6 series of 6 arrows each, in a time of 4 minutes per series each distance. 122 cm. target face for long distances and 80 cm. target face reduced to 6 rings for short distances.

Compound bow: 50 meters. Shoot 36 arrows in 6 series of 6 arrows each, in a time of 4 minutes per series. 80 cm. target face reduced to 6 rings for all categories.

Recurve Bow: Olympic Round.

- Under 15: 60 mts. (122cms target face)
- Under 17: 60 mts. (122cms target face)

9. - Regulations.
