At award ceremonies, the athlete shall be dressed in accordance with the Uniform Rules of the corresponding sport. **8. - Regulations.**

The regulations applied in this event will be the current ones established by the International Tae Kwon Do Federations and by the specifications set forth in this document.

9. - Judges and Referees.



Will be endorsed and appointed by the respective State Tae Kwon Do Association with the support of the State Technical Committee and according to the statutes of the respective sports federations.

10.- Awards.

- Plate or trophy to the entities that obtain from first to third place in each sport, according to Olympic qualification system.
- Medals to the winners of first, second and third place in each Sport, category, subcategory and division. The award will include a medal to the coach and an assistant (if any) per team.

12. - Technical Meeting.

Will be informative and will be made a day before each competition at 19:00 hours in the CAR facilities chaired by the Tae Kwon Do State Association, a representative of the Local Organizing Committee and representatives of the participating teams (Delegate and trainer, in which they will announce the final details for the proper running of the event.).

13. - Jury of Appeal:
